We will use the funds to make our club more accessible to those with or without a disability and to provide a discounted hot lunch for people who come in to see us. Any profits made from this will be reinvested in further improvements to our premises to make it a more comfortable and accessible place for all to visit.

We hope that by offering somewhere for people to come in and have some lunch they may find others in the same situation and therefore help their mental health.
